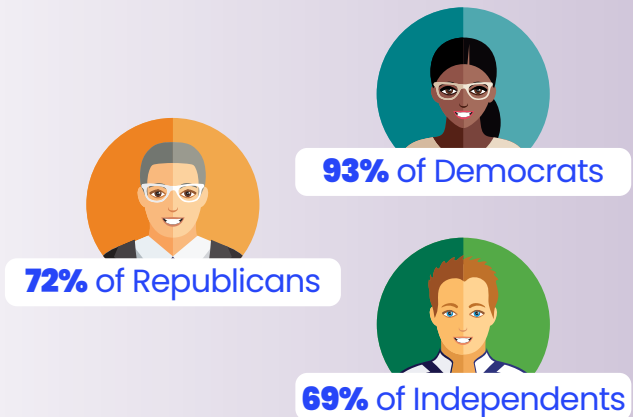

Candidate's Health Care Position Is Important to Voting Decision For 80% Of Wisconsin Voters

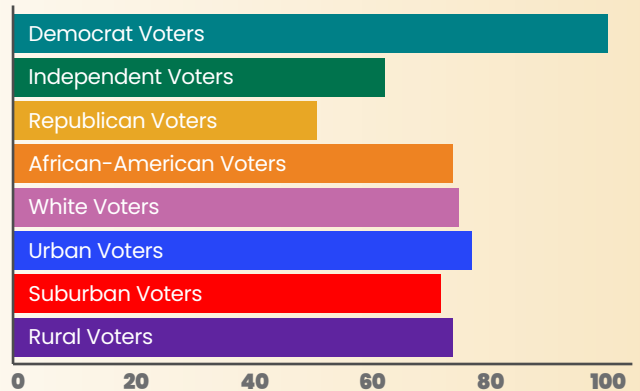


MAJORITIES OF VOTERS AGREE

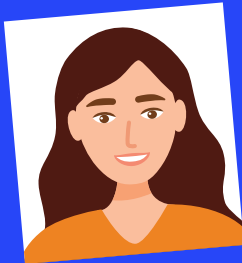

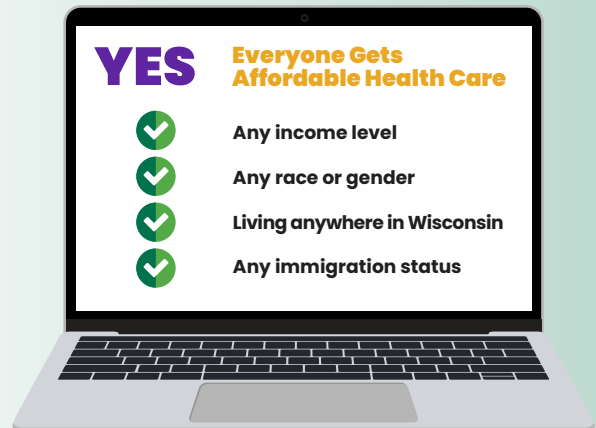
